Bishop Barber Authorizes Special Collection for Philippines

This weekend there will be a second collection for the victims of Typhoon Haiyan in the Philippines. The Diocese of Oakland has approved us to have it done this weekend, but we will accept any donations up until December 1st. All funds need to be sent to the Diocese by the 18th of December. So do your share by spreading the word.

In a letter to pastors and parishes this week, Bishop Barber authorized a special collection to be taken up in all diocesan parishes on the weekend of November 16-17 or the weekend of November 30-December 1, to support the relief effort in the aftermath of Typhoon Haiyan. The Bishop wrote, “I recall a Mission poster that read: ‘Christ has no hands, no feet, no ears, but yours.’ Will you be the hands, feet, and ears of Christ to our brothers and sisters enduring such great devastation and suffering? I am confident they can depend on your generosity.”
